Single seal coat on the following roads:

Berry Hill Rd Quarry Hill Rd Triggs Dr

Miscellaneous work needed:

Ball Park Ln (clean-up outfield)

Elm Tree Ln (clean-out waterway)

English Ridge Road (fill to build-up shoulder on hill, then wedge)

Spring Hill Rd (clean-up around sign at end)

Spry Hill Dr (ditch)

Wildflower Ln (clean-up)

Wilson Springs Rd (remove down tree)

Merry Hill Rd project:

Up size culvert at Martin's driveway.

Cut trees and bank back at base of hill.

Start ditching.

Scarify road surface through swamp.

Supervisor Buroker made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Sebranek seconded. Meeting adjourned at 1:50 pm.
