SPECIAL BOARD MEETING
August 20, 2026

A special meeting of the Town Board of Town of Marshall was held on Thursday, August 20, 2026, in the Town Hall. The purpose of the meeting was to review, discuss, and take possible action on Resolution 2026-5, Resolution Opposing the Proposed BECI 765kV Transmission Line Development within the Town of Marshall, Richland County, Wisconsin.

Chairman Durst called the meeting to order at 7:04 PM.

Present: Chairman Durst, Supervisor Sebranek, Supervisor Rynes, Clerk Berner, and over forty citizens.

Supervisor Sebranek moved to approve the posting and agenda. Supervisor Rynes seconded. Motion passed.

The Board reviewed draft copies of Resolution 2026-5.

Chairman Durst invited comments from the audience. Several people made comments and much discussion ensued.

At 7:33 PM, Supervisor Rynes made a motion to postpone action and schedule another meeting to rewrite the resolution to oppose the 765 kV transmission line.

Discussion commenced.

At 7:48 PM, Supervisor Rynes withdrew the previous motion. Supervisor Rynes made a new motion to rewrite the Town of Akan resolution to apply for the Town of Marshall.

Discussion continued. At the request of Chairman Durst, four words from the last paragraph were removed from the Town of Akan resolution.

At 8:02 PM, Chairman Durst seconded the motion to rewrite the Town of Akan resolution to apply for the Town of Marshall. Motion passed.

At 8:08 PM, **Roll call vote: Ayes 3, Nays: 0**

Chairman Durst moved to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Sebranek seconded.

The meeting adjourned at 8:10 PM.
